Common Core and Oregon Standards Comparison

"So many standards, so little time! How can teachers effectively teach and assess them all?" Across our State, teachers ask themselves this question every year when they review the Oregon State Content Standards newspaper. While most educators would agree the content standards identified in our State provide a valuable and comprehensive listing of important skills and concepts we want all students to learn, we also admit we just don't have enough time to guarantee our students will indeed gain proficiency at every content standard on the list. Dr. Douglas B. Reeves and his associate Larry Ainsworth have worked along with their colleagues to help educators effectively identify which content standards are *essential* for our students to be successful, and which are *nice to know*. The Leadership and Learning Center™ asks educators to consider the possibility the "depth of a fewer number of key concepts" is preferable to "covering superficially every concept in the book." The Center suggests our curriculum has consisted of a huge number of standards we are forced to teach only an "inch deep" in order to cover a "mile-wide" span of content. The following chart compares the number of Oregon State Standards with the new Common Core State Standards. Districts will still need to identify which standards are "priority" standards in order to teach those standards deeply and to monitor student progress through data teams.
